The donation will be used specifically to help the women in our Women's Employment program. This program is for women over the age of 35 who have become widowed, divorced or separated, relied on the absent partners income and have found themselves in need of life and employment skills, ultimately finding employment that enables them to be self sufficient. Because there is no state or federal funding for this gender specific problem, the funds that CPWN provides is the reason we are able to continue the program.

Our clients are able to meet one on one with a counselor, develop employment goals, create a resume and get help with interviewing, clothing and any additional life skills they need for employment retention (i.e. learning how to find a quality job, child care, budgeting etc).

Our client base for this program has escalated since our recent move back to Bel Air, and it is because of the members of CPWN that we are able to continue this program for the women in Harford County. Thank you so much.

Dear CPWN:

I wanted to send a very heartfelt and special thank you to all of the members of this great organization for your continuing support for SARC and our mission to end domestic violence, sexual violence, and stalking and to create a society free from abuse and fear.

As you know, SARC helps victims of abuse. What you may not know is that we offer a safe house, 24-hour hotline, food pantry, legal and counseling services and a companion program for rape and domestic violence victims seeking medical attention at local hospitals. We now have a special children's counselor on staff working in a special office where children can relate to the emotions of animals that decorate the walls along with special art therapy counseling. We currently have 14 children in our safe house – from 2 weeks to 16 years old. Over the holidays, we had 63 families adopted, gave out 120 meals, and had between 15 to 17 people in the safe house including children from ages 7 to 13.

Your generous donations – both from the recent Fashion Show and the holiday donation goes a long way toward meeting the needs of many. I am proud to be a member of CPWN along with you!

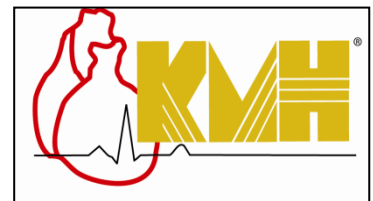
