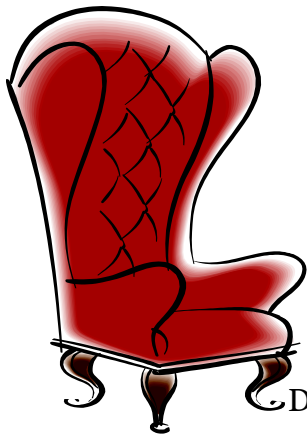

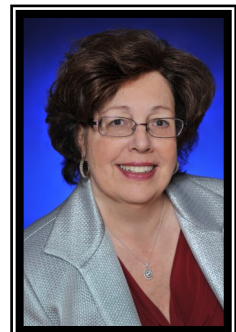

Don't let the shelves stay empty.

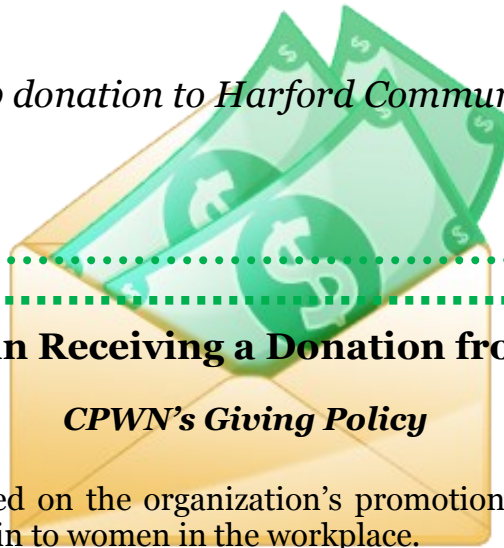
With just a \$20 donation, you can provide a bag of supplemental groceries to a low-income family who is wondering where their next meal will come from.
