Mentzell's auxiliary duties have included: the Crisis Negotiations Team (CNT), Emergency Vehicle Operator Course (EVOC) instructor, Sheriff's SCUBA Team, and the Crisis Intervention Team (CIT), among others. Lt. Mentzell is a MPCTC certified instructor and assists with teaching entrance level, in-service and specialized trainings. He was promoted to Lieutenant and transferred to the CAC in February of 2012. In June of 2016, Lt. Mentzell was appointed by Governor Larry Hogan as a member of the State Council on Child Abuse and Neglect (SCCAN).
